Sun. Discipleship Classes (11:30-12:30pm)

1. **Adults Class 1 ... Studying the Bible for Spiritual Growth** – Why read the Bible? What does this old book have to do with us in GTA in 2018? Do we treat the Bible like the daily horoscope? The Bible is far more meaningful to Christians. This class will provide the students with the tools to be able to read, interpret and apply the Bible into our lives today. Personal and group Bible study techniques will also be discussed and practiced. Course to be taught by Jimmy Young in the Sanctuary.
2. **Adult Class 2 ... How to Break a Sinful Habit** – Why is temptation so attractive and powerful? Why is it so easy to slip back into the same old sinful pattern? How can I find victory and deliverance? Most people know the cycle: We decide to break from a bad habit once and for all only to find ourselves right back at it after a short period of success. We will study together and discover spiritual answers to spiritual problems. We will look at practical tools the help us find freedom from enslaving patterns. Course to be taught by Pastor Vic in the north fellowship hall.
3. **Senior High Class** ... Today's class will join Jimmy Young's class in the Sanctuary as a small group.
4. **Junior High Class** ... The psalmist asks how a young person can keep their way pure, with the answer being "by keeping it according to Your word" (Psalm 119:9). Our Grade 6-8 Students will be focusing on writing His Word on the 'tablet of our heart.' Led by Enoch Tang & join us in Room 11.
5. **Children's Fellowship Hour** ... all children can be brought to the Choir Rm in the basement for this Fellowship Hour
